

Silvery Water and Starry Earth

Sofie Berzon Mackie was born in 1984 in London. She made Aliya to Israel at the age of 7 and lived since then in Kibbutz Be'eri.

For 3 years Berzon MacKie photographed her living room. Working with natural light and digital collages, she deepened her exploration of themes of motherhood, identity, love and loss, her generational heritage as an immigrant, and her lifelong journey of finding her place in the world.

Her solo show "Silvery Water and Starry Earth" will open January 12th at Studio of Her Own Gallery in Jerusalem. It will include photographs from her home in Be'eri and its surroundings, along with photographs of her childhood home in London, trying to recreate memories of both places now lost.





Berzon Mackie is a graduate of Technion Haifa photography school, Camera Obscura School of Art, Tel-Aviv, and Kalisher International Program for Curatorial Studies. Over the years she participated in solo and group exhibitions in Israel and worldwide, including Fresh Paint Art Fair Artist Greenhouse in 2019 (Tel Aviv) and 2023, Hanina Art Gallery (Tel Aviv), International Photography Festival (Tel Aviv), Eretz Israel Museum 2nd Biennial for Arts and Design (Tel Aviv), Sunny Art Centre (London), 7th Biennial of Fine Art & Documentary Photography - FotoNostrum gallery (Barcelona), Royal Academy of Arts (London). Independent Artist Fund grant recipient by the Israeli Ministry of Culture.
